Developed with the support of the Bicycle Industry Association of New Zealand (BIANZ) the courses combine theory and practice and will teach you to diagnose, service and repair bicycles of all types.

Courses are available in Auckland and Rotorua every February and July.

## Level 4 Certificate in Bicycle Mechanics (Bicycle Mechanic)

 Full time course – 18 weeks




Study in fully-equipped classrooms. You'll be expected to complete some self-directed study and work experience.
